

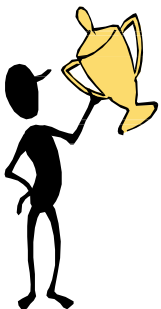
Tigershark Registration Guide

Be sure to visit each of these stations before you leave today. If you have any questions please don't hesitate to ask for assistance at the information table.

OK, now parents...Take your mark...Get set...GO!!!



- Swim Test (Pool area)** – All swimmers new to CFYN and any returning swimmers who are unsure which practice group they belong in will need to take a swim test. The swim test will determine which practice group you are assigned to for the beginning of the season.
- YMCA Representatives (2nd floor office)** – After your swim test, go to the YMCA reps where you will pay your program dues and if necessary sign up for your YMCA membership. Then take your swim test form signed by the coach to the Gym. (You can do this step after the Gym steps if you'd prefer.)
- Information (Gym)** – Drop your swim test form here then make sure all your paperwork is in order, pick up any missing forms and other information. Meet the new parent liaison. Anyone needing assistance is encouraged to stop here at any time during the registration process.
- Treasurer & Registration Forms (Gym)** - Pay your booster fees, divisional fees, deposit money into your escrow account, and turn in your Tigershark Registration, code of conduct, medical Forms, and t-shirt forms here. Pay your merchandise bill here as well.
- Volunteers & Officials (Gym)** - - Turn in your volunteer contract and find out more information about signing up to volunteer. Information about officials training will also be available.
- Aquatic Outfitters (Gym)** - Order your CFYN team swim suits and equipment here. Practice suits, goggles and other merchandise will also be available to purchase.
- Merchandise (Gym)** - - Order your CFYN team caps, hoodies, and extra team t-shirts for parents/siblings here. Other team merchandise and equipment will also be available to purchase. Credit card payments can be processed at the treasurer's table.
