CFYN TigerSharks Open Up Long Course Season

The CFYN TigerSharks swam the long course season opener held at YSU on May 15. Including numerous personal bests for many of the swimmers, Mia Dezelic, 10 of Stow, broke a team record in the 10 and Under 50 Back with a 36.81 and Marissa Bowers, 15 of Cuyahoga Falls broke a team record in the 15 and over 100 back with a 1:16.57.

Other swimmers placing at the meet include: Savannah Cossin, 8 of Stow, Dylan Cossin, 12 of Stow, Ana Dezelic, 7 of Stow, Evie Lewis, 13 of Cuyahoga Falls, Jacob Hickin, 11 of Stow, and Keith Turnbull, 11 of Silver Lake.

The TigerSharks continued a winning streak the following weekend at the Buseby Invitational held at CSU on May 20-22. Marissa Bowers broke her own record swimming the 100 back in 1:16:06 and broke another team record in the 15 and over 200 back with a 2:47:17. Keith Turnbull broke a team record in the 11-12 yr 100 Fly with a 1:15:43. Swimmers advancing to the finals held Saturday night included Keith Turnbull, Dylan Cossin, Alex Cimera, 11 of Ravenna and Luke Cimera, 11 of Ravenna.

Alex Cimera placed 3rd in the 100 Back; Alex Cimera placed 7th in the 200 IM; Dylan Cossin placed 8th in the 200 IM, 3rd in 100 Fly, 8th in 200 Free, 6th in 50 Fly, 7th in 100 Breaststroke and 4th in 400 Free; Keith Turnbull placed 1st in 100 Fly, 1st in 50 Free, 2nd in 100 Back, 1st in 200 Free, 3rd in 50 Fly, 2nd in 100 Free and 2nd in 400 Free.

The meet concluded with Keith Turnbull winning the meet high point award with a score of 141 points.
